Plans to pioneer cNGN Stablecoin in financial innovation underway



The Central Bank of Nigeria (CBN) has granted the Africa Stablecoin tablecoin Consortium (ASC) approval to introduce Compliant Nigerian naira stableCoin (cNGN) within its regulatory sandbox

This marks a pivotal moment in the Nigerian financial landscape, as the ASC, comprising leading financial institutions, fintech innovators, and blockchain experts in the country, focuses on monetary transactions.

Scheduled to go live on February 27, 2024, the cNGN is backed 1:1 by naira reserves in designated commercial banks and expected to propel the naira

scale, the ASC mentioned in its official statement. Meanwhile, the apex bank has released new guidelines to regulate the operations of bank accounts for Virtual Assets Service Providers (VASPs), otherwise known

as cryptocurrency.

The new rules, published on CBN's website, flesh out the regulator's decision last month to lift its prohibition on banks operating accounts for crypto service providers. The framework provides minimum standards and requirements for banking business relationships and account opening for VASPs, and-creates an effective

monitoring of the activities of banks and Other Financial Institutions (OFIs) in providing service Securities and Exchange Commission (SEC) licensed VASPs/Digital Assets (DA) entities in the country.

Among other things, the document also sought to ensure effective risk management in the banking industry with regard to the operations of licensed VASPs.

The new guidelines followed the lifting of the ban that previously barred banks from operating accounts for crypto assets, although banks are still not allowed to hold or trade in crypto assets themselves.

"Current trends globally have shown that there is need to regulate the activities of virtual assets service providers which include cryptocurrencies and cryptoassets," it said.

CBN Director, Financial Policy and Regulation Department, Mr. Haruna Mustafa, in a circular addressed to banks and other financial institutions, stated that banks are "still prohibited from holding, trading and/or transacting in virtual currencies on their

Customs generates N30b

he Nigeria Customs Service (NCS), Murtala Muhammed International Airport (MMIA) Command, said it generated N30.503b revenue in 2023.

The Customs Area Controller (CAC), Comptroller Charles Orbih, who disclosed this during a press briefing at the command's headquarters in Lagos, said the revenue surpassed the N29.148b target.

Providing an overview of the command's performance, Orbih said: "In December 2023 alone, the command collected N4.768b as revenue for government.

He also stated that the command within the same period under review, 125 seizures with a Duty Paid Value (DPV) of N801.561m was made. He listed the seized items to include \$10,000 counterfeit notes handed over to the Economic and

Financial Crimes Commission (EFCC) \$8,800 concealed in an album, 89 seized drones, and 66 detained drones

Other seized items consist of 330 military and security wares, 700 rolls of cigarettes, 126 walkie-talkies with accessories, 87 artifacts and antiquities, 22 elephant tusks, 300 pairs of ladies' footwear, two bags of precious stones, and other items.

Orbih revealed that three suspects arrested in connection with the seizures would be charged to court on completion of investigation.

The CAC commended the commitment and diligence of the officers and men of the command, acknowledging the support received from the Comptroller General of Customs, Bashir Adewale Adeniyi and his management team through creating an enabling environment for the command to operate.

recent report titled 'Global Petrol Prices, Octane-95, January 1, 2024' has highlighted the substantial discrepancies in gasoline prices worldwide, positioning Nigeria as the 22nd country with the most affordable petrol on a global scale.

report, accessible on their website, highlights the average global gasoline price at 1.29 US dollars per litre, drawing attention to the significant variations influenced by individual countries' diverse taxes and subsidies.

"The average price of gasoline around the world is 1.29 US dollars per litre. However, there is a substantial difference in these prices among

"As a general rule, richer countries have higher per litre. prices while poorer countries and the

countries that produce and export oil have significantly lower prices. One notable exception is the U.S., which is an economically advanced country but has low gas prices.

"The differences in prices across countries are due to the various taxes and subsidies for gasoline. All countries have access to the same petroleum prices of international markets but then decide to impose different taxes. As a result, the retail price of gasoline is different," the report said.

Iran secures the top spot for offering the world's cheapest gasoline at a remarkably low \$0.029 (equivalent to N26.52) per litre, while Hong Kong leads with the highest price recorded at \$3.101 (approximately N2,835.77)

5.1.2 The official record of tenders is attached herewith as Appendix III

6.0 EVALUATION OF TENDERS

- 6.1 <u>FINANCIAL APPRAISAL</u>: The Financial appraisal of Tenders was undertaken to evaluate and rank the relative competitive advantage of the tenderers with regards to the expected final contract price and completion period. The appraisal was done under the following headings and criteria set out in item 3.2 above:
 - a. <u>Arithmetic Checks:</u> To determine the corrected tender price and the level of care taken in preparing the tender by computing the naira value and the total number of errors in the tenders.
 - b. Tender Completion Period: To determine the tender with the must realistic completion period.
 - c. <u>Comparative Price Analysis:</u> This comprises an analysis of tender price distribution and bill price distribution. The results of the analysis will reveal the tenderers pricing strategy, and thus determine the consistency and structure of each tender.
 - d. <u>Comparative Rate Analysis:</u> This involves the application of statistical tools in the comparison of a randomly selected list of cost-significant bills items to determine the likely effects of variations in quantities of measured work that would affect the final contract price. The result of this analysis reveals the relative sensitivity of each tender to changes in quantities.

6.1.2 Arithmetical Errors

- a) In line with the foregoing set evaluation parameters, all received tenders were subjected to thorough arithmetical checks for correction of errors that may arise from:
 - Discrepancies between the stated amount in figures and in words;
 - ii. Discrepancies in the unit rates and line item total amount resulting from the multiplication of the unit rate by the corresponding quantity;
 - iii. Figures transfer to collections and summaries;
 - iv. Additions of figures in the collections and summaries; and

v. Identification of any omissions of rates and prices of any item of works

6.1.3 Comparative Rates Analysis:

- The analysis for the key rates is shown in **Table 5** below. The table contains schedules of key rates in each Tenderer's Bills of Quantities. These shall form the basis of comparison with the Consultant's rates for the same items, and will be used to ascertain the following: -
- i. The rate structure of each tender relative to the expected (Consultant's) rates for the items. This will identify the tenderer's pricing strategy and the consistency of pricing level, whether low, high, average or mixed.
- The prices listed in the rate analysis shall also be used to analyze the likely effects of increase/decrease in measured work quantities on the Contract Prices using statistical tools. This is especially important where Quantities will vary significantly during execution of the works.
- iii. The mean prices of a random selection of Tender Rates reveal each Tenderer's pricing strategy at a micro level.
 - The Bill rates dispersion measures the closeness of the tender rates to the Consultant's rates of a random selection of Bills of Quantities items. A dispersion of 1.00 indicates perfect correlation between the tender price and the Consultant's rates of same items of work. Dispersion of or close to 1.00 indicates a relatively consistent rate structure that clusters near the Consultant's prices.
